WESTERN PLACER AMATEUR RADIO CLUB NET SCRIPT

October 2, 2013 Script Revision

I. Opening the Net

Good evening and welcome to the Western Placer Amateur Radio Club weekly net. This is (give your call sign) on the W6SAR repeater of the Placer County Search and Rescue Team. My name is (give your first name). I am located in (state the city name where you are) and I will be tonight's Net Control.

This is a directed net for the purpose of passing information on to the membership of the Western Placer Amateur Radio Club. Please do not transmit unless invited to do so by Net Control. Anyone having emergency or priority traffic may break in at any time.

If there are any Club Officers or Board Members who have announcements or business for the Net, please come now with your call sign. (acknowledge anyone who calls and after they finish their announcement ask if anyone has any questions)

We ask all club members to leave your radio on during the day tuned to this repeater so you can respond to other stations that transmit on this frequency who may need assistance or simply wish to chat with other amateur radio operators.

If anyone must leave the net early and wants to check in now, please come with your call sign.

II. Station Check in Portion of the Net

This is (give your call sign) We will now move on to the Station Check in portion of our net. Club members are asked to check in by call sign suffix in groups: <u>Alpha through Golf</u> (A through G), <u>Hotel through Mike</u> (H through M), <u>November through Sierra</u> (N through S) and <u>Tango through Zulu</u> (T through Z).

When you check in, please give your call sign, name and location and I'll acknowledge you. At the conclusion of all groups I'll invite any late or missed club members to check in. Lastly I'll invite any visitors or guests who would like to check in.

(Drop the repeater for 2 seconds. The repeater will time out and stop transmitting if you transmit longer than 2 minutes without a pause.)

I now invite any members with a call sign suffix beginning with the letters <u>A through G</u>, <u>Alpha through Golf</u> to please check in at this time.

I now invite any members with a call sign suffix beginning with the letters <u>H through M, Hotel through Mike</u> to please check in at this time.

I now invite any members with a call sign suffix beginning with the letters <u>N through S</u>, <u>November through Sierra</u> to please check in at this time.

I now invite any members with a call sign suffix beginning with the letters <u>T through Z, Tango through Zulu</u> to please check in at this time.

(Be sure to acknowledge each station individually that checks in)

This is (give your call sign). Any late or missed club members who would like to check in, please come now with your call sign.

Are there any <u>visitors or guests</u> who would like to check into to the Western Placer Amateur Radio Club Net? If so please come with your <u>call sign PHONETICALLY to help us copy your call accurately</u>. Also please give your name and your location.

III. Club Member Information Sharing and Discussion Protion of the Net

This is the time for any WPARC members to share any HAM radio related news such as: upcoming HAM events or activities; equipment you wish to buy, sell or have recently acquired; technical questions related to Ham radio; recent contacts you made or other items of interest to our members. Please come now with your call sign and I will acknowledge you so you can make your comment, announcement or ask questions. (Be sure to acknowledge each station that responds individually)

IV. Closing the Net

This is (give your call sign) net control for the Western Placer Amateur Radio Club weekly net. Before I close the net, this is the final call for any stations that would like to check in now who have not already done so to please come with your call sign.

For those that are able don't forget the HF net tonight following this 2 meter net on the frequency announced by Michael K6BUK in his weekly newsletter. (K6BUK will also announce the frequency at the beginning of the 2 meter net but it not you should give the frequency again here as a reminder) If you wish to volunteer to be net control for an upcoming session of this 2 meter club net, please contact Dennis our Net manager at ki6hha@aol.net.

This concludes the Western Placer Amateur Radio Club net. This net meets weekly at 1930 hours on this W6SAR repeater. Thank you all for checking in and participating in tonight's net by making yourselves and your equipment available. We look forward to hearing from you in future sessions.
